

Post-ICIS *MIS Quarterly* Reviewer Development Workshop

MIS Quarterly will offer a post-ICIS Reviewer Development Workshop on Wednesday, December 14, 2016 from 1:00 – 5:00 pm at the ICIS conference location (exact location will be posted later). The workshop has a limited capacity of 50 selected applicants.

MIS Quarterly expects virtuous reviewing as described in the following editorial: [Writing a Virtuous Review](#). The objective of the workshop is to coach individuals who have reviewed, or are interested in reviewing, for *MISQ* on how to develop a virtuous review. The workshop is designed to provide participants in the workshop with (1) feedback from *MISQ* Senior Editors and Associate Editors on a review that the participants develop for the workshop and (2) the opportunity to discuss with editors and other participants on how to develop a virtuous review.

Individuals selected for the workshop will be assigned a paper to review based on their research expertise and interests and will be expected to submit their review prior to the workshop. The assigned paper will be an initial submission to *MISQ*.

The workshop will include:

1. Roundtable discussions among reviewers and *MISQ* editors to provide feedback on submitted reviews and to discuss the “actual” review packet for the paper.
2. Editors’ panel discussion on characteristics of virtuous reviewing, structuring reviews, and reviewing revisions.

There will be a \$100 registration fee for the workshop.
